


Figure 1. Driveway and Common Road Intersection




Figure 2. Steep Driveway Intersecting With Road

iveways Intersecting With Common Roads: The common road shall always retain two while passing driveways. The crown on the driveway shall gradually flatten and join to mon road at the same level as the edge of the road surface (refer to Figure 1). No was soft from the driveway shall spill onto the common road. The most difficult driveway exsection is when the driveway meets the common road from a steep down-hill slope. To ke ter from spilling onto the road from the driveway, the driveway may have to be leveled of the road from the intersection point of the road (refer to Figure 2). The culvert is place the original ditch and backfilled to a flat surface even with the edge of the road surface. The ted lines indicate the original ditch.
